Symptoms at home or in school Check for any New/Unexplained*












SYMPTOMS

- Fever (100F) or chills
- Feels feverish
- Cough, shortness of breath
- Sore throat, nasal congestion, or runny nose
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste/smell
- Nausea/vomiting
- Diarrhea
- MIS-C symptoms:
- abdominal pain bloodshot eyes rash, neck pain
- * If student has a documented chronic condition that accounts for symptoms, they are not considered "new/unexplained 5 Day Quarantine ** if... (If fully vaccinated, no exclusion, should test 5 days





When to Return to School

Get COVID-19 Test

Positive Test

SYMPTOM onset ** 5 days after

AND

(without use of meds) 24 hours of NO fever

AND

Symptoms have improved

Negative Test

(without use of meds) 24 hours of NO fever

SYMPTOM onset

AND

5 days after

AND

Symptoms have improved

(without use of meds) 24 hours of NO fever

AND

Symptoms have improved

after exposure and use a facemask for 10 days.)

indicating alternative Doctor's note diagnosis







Traveled outside the country or on a cruise ship

If you test positive on day 5 of isolation, you must continue to isolate for a total of 10 days (retesting is not required to return
